The SA Constitution:

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY:

Except to the extent that the *Trade Practices Act 1974(Cth)* or other legislation applies, and cannot by contract be excluded, I agree that as a term of my membership that I absolve SA from all liability however arising from injury or damage however caused (whether fatal or otherwise) arising out of my membership and/or participation in any SA authorized recognized activity in any way due to any negligent act, breach of duty, default and/or omission one on the part of SA.

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY:

1. Release and forever discharge them from all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses, damages, penalties, costs and expenses however arising that I may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with my membership and /or participation in any SA authorized or recognized activity; and
2. ASSOCIATE

- Those persons who support one of the branches of the Association but do not participate in any competition
- They may take examinations to become commissioned officials and, if successful, act as officials (subject to the rules relating to that activity);
- They may become members of the appropriate accredited coaches committee (subject to the rules relating to that group and upon payment of the prescribed fees);
- They may hold office in the Association and its committees, the State and their committees, and the clubs (subject to the rules relating to those groups);
- They may be a member of only one (1) club or none at all;

RECREATIONAL

- Those persons who have not previously been a member of Skate Australia
- Recreational Skaters within the Speed Branch
- Mini Rollers/Exhibition Skaters within the Artistic Branch
- In-house players within the Inline Hockey & Roller Hockey Branches
- They may upgrade with the payment of the prescribed Upgrade fees

DEVELOPMENT

- Those persons participating in **intra-club** competitions and programs, **including those** against CompetitiveMembers.
- They may participate in **inter-club Novice and Development Level** competitions within their own state but only against other Development **Members** unless an exemption applies as follows:
 - Competitive members may compete against members in an inter-club Novice or Development Level Artistic competition provided the Competitive member is not competing in their **primary artistic discipline**.
 - They may participate in Bronze Bar Proficiency Tests
 - They may not participate in State Leagues, State or National Championships
 - They must be a member of a club unless they reside outside forty (40) kilometer radius from the nearest registered club in which case they will be known as "unattached" Development Member.
 - They may hold office in the Association, its committees, States or their committees, and at club level (subject to the rules pertaining to that group).
 - They may upgrade to competitive member with the payment of the prescribed Upgrade fees.

COMPETITIVE

- Those persons participating in **inter-club** competitions including state leagues, state championships, national championships and international events.
- They may participate in Proficiency Medal tests (subject to the rules relating to those programs)
- They must be a member of a club unless they reside outside forty (40) kilometer radius from the nearest registered club in which case they will be known as "unattached" Competitive Member.
- They may hold office in the Association and its committees (subject to the rules pertaining to those groups).
- They may not re-join the Association as a Development level member at any time.
